Good morning,

Given the rapid escalation of events in the last 48 hours and the Governor's new statewide [directive](#) to cancel gatherings of 250 people or more, we must cancel our upcoming Sacramento Warlords Basketball Tournament on March 21 & 22, 2020.

Our two hotels, Courtyard by Marriott Sacramento Midtown and Holiday Inn Express & Suites Elk Grove, have been notified of our tournament cancellation due to COVID-19. Please contact your hotel directly to cancel your individual reservations.

Full refunds of registration fees will be made to your original form of payment. Please allow us the next couple of weeks to process your refund.

At this time, the Governor's announcement is a recommendation (not a mandate) and Sacramento County has not issued any new directive on event cancellations. The Governor's policy does not apply to school classes and Sacramento City Unified School District currently remains open. Nonetheless, we believe that it is best to take a proactive approach and cancel our tournament to better protect the players, families and community.

We are deeply saddened not to be able to provide the kids with the opportunity to play. It was our intent to host our tournament despite these challenges, especially for the senior players, but it is simply not the reasonable nor responsible course of action at this time.
